Item 5: Meeting Minutes

- 1. Call to Order- Chair Meagor called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.
- 2. Roll Call

- 5. Review and Approve Meeting Minutes
 - a. Approval of May 2, 2024 minutes

- 6. New Business
 - a. Survivor of cardiac arrest introductions John Miller, the importance of the Survivor Celebration

CQI Coordinator Price-Fair presented a staff report and introduced Mr. John Miller.

Mr. Miller discussed the Twelfth Annual Survivor Celebration where he met the dispatcher, paramedics, and medical care givers who were instrumental in his survival and recovery. He described his cardiac event that occurred in the Indian Valley College swimming pool. The response time for the Marin County Fire Department was two minutes. There were six survivors at the celebration including a dog.

Chair Meagor opened the meeting to public comments.

There was no public in attendance.

Chair Meagor closed the meeting to public comments.

The Board thanked Mr. Miller for telling his story and wished him well.

b. Adoption of FY 2024/25 budget by Resolution 2024-01

Acting Executive Officer Pomi presented the staff report. There is a projected increase of 7% in Revenue and an increase of up to 8% in Expenditures. The RVPA policy with respect to the Reserve Account is to have 20% of projected Expenditures for the Fiscal Year. There is currently \$1.1 million in the Assigned General Fund Reserve which meets the intent of the Reserve Policy. The net position from Fiscal Year 2022/23 had changed with a positive amount of \$690,092. Staff is recommending that amount be transferred to the Unassigned Fund Balance for Assigned Vehicles and Equipment Replacement. He discussed the spreadsheet regarding prior year and current year balances, pooled cash, Accounts Payable, and Miscellaneous Deposits. Staff answered questions from the Board regarding when the Executive Officer must get Board approval for an Expenditure from the Reserve Account; if there is a replacement schedule for the defibrillators; possible impacts to the RVPA from AB 2408 (chemical retardants found in gear).

c. Adoption of Classification Fund Balances by Resolution 2024-02

Acting Executive Officer Pomi presented the staff report. This action is required per Governmental Accounting Standards Board (GASB) Pronouncement #54. There were no questions from the Board.

d. E-bike injuries report out by CQI Coordinator Heather Price-Fair

CQI Coordinator Price-Fair presented a staff report. She will provide a more thorough report at the end of the year which could include Novato and San Rafael. She discussed some of the statistics including gender, age, location, city, and month of incident.

Board member Candell asked if there was a breakdown per e-bike classifications. CQI Coordinator Price-Fair stated "no". She would need to bring this request to County EMS but the information could be included in the narrative.

Board member Candell asked that the age category be broken down to eleven through fifteen.

Board member Casissa asked for data regarding transports and non-transports and if the locations could be mapped.

Board member Finn asked if there is an emerging trend in the types of injuries that come with e-bikes. CQI Coordinator Price-Fair stated concussions can occur with the younger kids that are not wearing helmets. There are more rib and clavicle fractures or head injuries in people over the age of 50. There is nothing that is "e-bike" specific.

Board member Candell asked if the report could include the cause of the accident or whether a vehicle was involved. CQI Coordinator Price-Fair stated this information could be included in the narrative.

Board member Casissa stated the more information they have, the better the legislation they can create.

e. RVPA Subcommittee

Acting Executive Officer Pomi presented a staff report. The subcommittee met on May 28th. Consulting firm City Gate received data that was in an unusable format. City Gate has been asked to contact the Marin County IT Department.

Board member Robbins discussed the dilemma for the Town of Ross when the station is eventually closed. The delays are frustrating and a real problem for Ross. The 2019 study was quite extensive.

Acting Executive Officer Pomi stated Executive Officer Weber is in touch with the County Sheriff's Department trying to come up with a resolution.

Board member Candell stated the Board would be happy to assist in any way.

Board member Finn stated "unformattable" data is a death sentence- "reformattable" data can be extracted. The original target of June will need to be bumped up.

f. Review and discuss the start time of RVPA Meetings

Board member Corbett discussed his suggestion of moving the meeting start time to 5:30 p.m.

Board member Candell stated he would not be able to get to a 5:30 p.m. meeting.

Board member Robbins agreed. She would be in favor of starting the meeting at 6:00 p.m. if that works for everybody.

Board member Casissa noted there were a number of calls to San Rafael. CQI Coordinator Price-Fair stated it happens on occasion.

Board member Candell asked how the amount of contribution to the RVPA is determined. Acting Executive Officer Pomi stated the Revenue is via a tax measure and it is \$97.50 per parcel. It is not based on use.

The Board thanked CQI Coordinator Price-Fair for her great work!

11. Announcements/Future Agenda Items

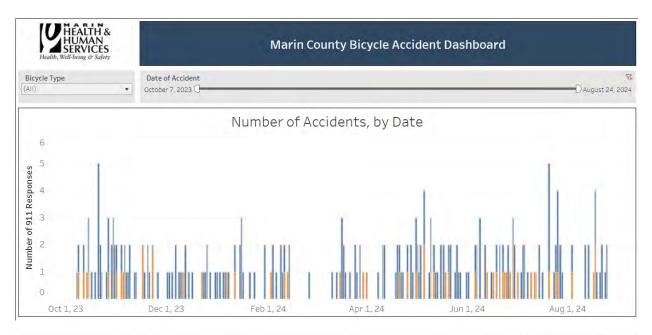

SUBJECT: Replacement Ambulance

MEETING DATE: September 5, 2024

DISCUSSION:

Medic 18 is a 2019 ambulance with 90,000 miles. Lead times on emergency apparatus post pandemic have been as long as 2 years. With the mileage reaching nearly 100K and long lead times staff is recommending replacement of the ambulance.

There are several options for your Boards consideration related to the purchase of a new ambulance:

- Utilize an existing cooperative purchase agreement allowing municipalities to purchase apparatus from vendors that have pre-existing competitively bid offerings.
- Piggy-back on a completely bid ambulance procurement from another public agency.
- Develop a specification for a new ambulance and place that specification out to competitive bid. Return to your Board to award the bid.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff research indicates that the cost of a new ambulance including taxes, is just over \$500,000. Staff is recommending utilizing an existing cooperative purchase agreement with a reputable builder. This option allows for competitive pricing and reduces delays. Staff is requesting the Board provide the Executive Officer authority to enter into a purchase agreement utilizing an existing cooperative purchasing agreement with a cost not to exceed \$525,000 for the replacement of our 2019 International Ambulance.

SUBJECT: Update on operational deployment and legal analysis for RVPA

MEETING DATE: September 5, 2024

BACKGROUND:

The Ross Valley Paramedic Authority was established as a Joint Powers Agreement in 1982 providing paramedic services to the greater Ross Valley. The JPA consists of eight-Member agencies: the Towns of Corte Madera, Larkspur, Kentfield, Ross, San Anselmo, and Fairfax, the Sleepy Hollow Fire Protection District, and the County of Marin.

In approximately, the first 20 years of service, the RVPA operated a single transport ambulance and utilized private providers to back up the RVPA's primary unit. In or around 1997, Corte Madera proposed adding its own ambulance to serve Corte Madera and to back up the RVPA's primary ambulance. After considerable deliberations, Corte Madera entered into a sub-contract agreement with RVPA to provide ALS paramedic care and transport beginning in or around 1998. As the system became busier, adjustments were made to the service area boundaries, shifting some workload from the RVPA ambulance to the Corte Madera ambulance. Additionally, in 2002, the Engine-Medic Program was created, adding ALS care to Ross Valley Fire engines at the Western most end of the RVPA service area and to Larkspur Fire engines at the eastern end.

In 2018, Larkspur and Corte Madera consolidated their respective Fire Departments into a Joint Powers Authority now known as the Central Marin Fire Department. Currently, Central Marin Fire is operating under a sub-contract agreement with RVPA.

DISCUSSION:

RVPA received correspondence from Larkspur City Manager Dan Schwarz on February 23, 2024. In the letter, Larkspur expresses its interest in exploring alternatives to the current RVPA governance and service model on the grounds that the model is inefficient. City Manager Schwarz proposes that Corte Madera and Larkspur withdraw from the RVPA, and that Central Marin Fire become the exclusive ambulance service provider for all of Larkspur and Corte Madera.

Ambulance service differs from fire protection or other emergency municipal services in that pre-hospital care and transport generate revenue for the provider. As in most

Counties throughout the State, areas within a County are broken down into "exclusive operating areas ("EOAs" or, in Marin's case, "Paramedic Service Areas"). Marin County currently has five Paramedic Service Areas (Novato, San Rafael, Ross Valley, Southern Marin, and West Marin). These Areas within a County are generally designated to a single service provider to ensure system stability and in many cases for exclusivity related to any revenue generated.

Your Board previously created a Subcommittee to explore acquiring the services of a consulting firm to develop a Deployment Study in connection with the request from the Town of Ross to enter a longer-term lease agreement for housing Medic 18 and its paramedics. Subsequent, to the sub-committee being formed the request from Larkspur City Manager was received. The sub-committee was then tasked to work with staff to develop both legal and operational analysis of overall resource deployment and impacts of changes to governance within the greater Ross Valley.

At your March 2024 meeting, your Board directed staff to engage the services of Citygate and specialty legal services of Wright, L'Estrange & Ergastolo. Your Boards legal Counsel Emily Longfellow led the work surrounding the legal analysis and has the necessary information to compliment the operational/deployment analysis from Citygate. Ms. Longfellow provided an update to the RVPA Board Sub-Committee recently.

We have suffered significant delays surrounding the data for the deployment analysis. We feel we are at a point after significant work, that the data is accurate and can be used by Citygate to develop modeling and ultimately be able to engage the RVPA Board and stakeholders in meaningful dialogue.

Next steps will include Citygate re-running their analysis with the updated data set. Once they have a clear picture of operational deployment, Ciytgate will begin stakeholder interviews which include member agencies, fire agencies and the EMS agency. After Citygate completes their interviews, your Counsel (Emily Longfellow) will work with Citygate to prepare a presentation that will go to the Board Sub-Committee and ultimately the full RVPA Board.

RECOMMENDATION:

Your Board receives this update and directs staff as necessary.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Your Board has previously committed \$30,000 for this project, we remain within the budget for this project.
